In many words ending in **-alm**, the **L** is totally silent. You just make a long "ah" sound.

- **Salmon** /'sæmən/ (A pink fish) — *Wait! This one is special. We don't say the L, and the O sounds like "un".*
- **Calm** /kɑ:m/ (Relaxed and quiet)
- **Palm** /pɑ:m/ (The inside of your hand)

### Practice Sentence:

"The **calm** fisherman eats **salmon** in the shade of a **palm** tree."

### The Silent "T" (t)

When you see **-stl-** in the middle of a word, the **T** is silent. It sounds like a double "S."

- **Castle** /'kæsl/ (A big stone house for a King)
- **Whistle** /'wɪsl/ (Making a high sound with your mouth)

- **Wrestle** /'resəl/ (To fight or grab someone)

"The **Gnat** flew to the **Castle**. A **calm** man was eating **salmon** with his **thumb**. The man heard a **whistle** and dropped his **knife**. It was the **wrong** time to **wrestle**!"
